Jumping in front of about vehicles near the Burning Man mutant vehicles on the move is not only stupid but also wildly inadvisable. Some vehicles may have difficulty stopping quickly, not to mention that it's really not any fun (for the driver or passengers) to suddenly slam on the brakes with a giant-fire breathing-dragonload of 40 dancing people. Admire the art, but stay out of their path!

the Man's "L3K" perimeter of orange ground lights is populated with pedestrians at every hour of the day. While it's understood that sometimes a piece of mobile art or a mutant vehicle interacts with the Man in a creative way, for the most part, vehicles are encouraged to park away from the Man and outside of the "L3K" perimeter (and avoid driving over it). Flame effects and fire-breathing vehicles are discouraged from this area, for obvious reasons. Pay attention to the vibe when you pull into the Man, or up to any other art piece - blasting your music _may or may not be a welcome addition to the moment at hand, but don't assume.

YOUR BIKE IN BRC

LIGHTS! Make sure you have both front and rear lights on your bike ALWAYS LOCK YOUR BIKE if you want to find it where you left it. Bicycles only get stolen or "borrowed" when they're unlocked, and the unfortunate reality is that many bikes are stolen or misappropriated in BRC every year. The only bikes that should NEVER be locked are green Community Bikes - these bikes are

information Community Bikes, you say? A chaos.) group of volunteer burners from Reno maintains a fleet of anonymously donated community bikes, available for anyone to ride. Community bikes are easy to spot because they are painted BRIGHT GREEN with the words "Yellow Bike" painted on the frame. Here are a few things to keep in mind when using a Community Bike. It's only really "yours" when you re riding

it.Community Bikes should be treated with respect, as if it was your own. Don't trash it, break it, or vandalize it! Don't forget personal hygiene... pants are required while riding a community bike. Yep. Seriously DON'T EVER LOCK UP A COMMUNITY BIKE. The Bike Camp team will cut any locks from these green bikes if they see them. Don't bring a attention to the flagging teams who are there

Community Bike into your tent or RV and please, don't take it home when you leave the playa If a Community Bike breaks while you're using it, use -your Radical Self-Reliance to get it repaired for the next person: Check with Playa Info at Center Camp for a bike you think you'll skip the line by heading out any side repair camp if you don't have the tools to or can't do it yourself (DIY). Community Bikes are meant for short trips. Grab a community bike, make your trek, and then drop it off where you found it, or leave it in an obvious public place.
